Concept of Maintenance of any type of Equipments/Machinery







Maintenance refers to the process of preserving the best condition of an asset, equipment, machinery, documents, personal health and Hygiene etc. The technical meaning of maintenance involves functional checks, servicing,

repairing or replacing necessary spares of any equipment, machinery and supporting utilities.

TYPES OF MAINTENANCE: Maintenance is basically classified in to two types:

A <u>Preventive Maintenance</u>: The process of initiating tasks and maintenance plans to prevent breakdowns/failures. It is a maintenance strategy based on replacing/restoring an asset/spare at fixed intervals regardless of its condition. It can be periodical maintenance such as daily, weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly, half yearly, yearly etc. It can also be based on usage of machinery/equipment for fixed running hours such as 10000 hours, 20000 hours etc. as per OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) recommendations. This **Preventive Maintenance** is categorized in to various types:

Proactive Maintenance: It is a preventive maintenance strategy to correct the root causes of failure and avoid breakdowns caused by underlying conditions.

<u>Predictive Maintenance</u>: The process of tracking normal operation of an equipment/machinery to detect possible defects before they become defective. It enables to save money on breakdown repairs by taking appropriate action well before any damage occurs resulting in downtime.

Planned Maintenance: The process of correcting / fixing any system / equipment / machinery by anticipating any breakdown well in advance. It covers maintenance tasks which are planned, scheduled and documented to reduce downtime from unexpected breakdowns. It involves simple and regular planned inspections and periodical maintenance of equipment/machinery.

Routine Maintenance: It refers to maintenance tasks carried out on a planned basis to identify and prevent failures by regular inspections.

Condition Based Maintenance: The process of taking prompt action on a machinery/equipment that is in the early stages of breakdown. It is applied when a machine/equipment alerts that the system is beginning to malfunction before breakdown occur

Preventive maintenance Improves life span and reliability of equipment/asset/machinery.

Minimizes downtime due to breakdowns.

Prevents unexpected equipment failures

Reduces likely hood of breakdowns

3. Corrective Maintenance:

The maintenance tasks which are carried out in response or reaction to fix a failed machine/equipment which needs urgent repairs. It involves in restoring broken down equipment to normal operational condition with the assistance of technicians with back up of spares.

This **Corrective Maintenance** is categorized in to various types:

Reactive Maintenance: It refers to repairs that are done when an equipment/machinery has already broken down, to bring it in to operational condition.

Emergency Maintenance: Maintenance carried out under a condition or a situation which poses a danger to the system, equipment, machinery etc. It requires immediate attention for the safety of personnel and property.

Breakdown Maintenance: Maintenance performed on any equipment / machinery that has broken down completely and cannot be operated. This is also called Runto-Failure maintenance. It is more expensive than preventive maintenance.

Cyber Security Awareness

Cyber security awareness is a must for everyone and training on the same is too vital to security. This is a key topic because many people assume if they have the best security technologies, it will provide them with 100% safety of their data. Large corporations and governments spend huge amounts and still aren't immune from cyber-attacks. Another common belief is that the IT department will take care of it or assume that a firewall and anti-virus will protect them against anything. But, we must not forget that these tips that keep you safe at work, will also keep you safe at home!

Cybersecurity awareness is for... Employees, Business owners, Parents, Kids, seniors & everyone. The following are some of the Do's and Don't's.

Guard yourself against Phishing

- Common email scams employ email messages and even websites that look official, but are in fact attempts to steal your identity to commit fraud. This is the activity commonly known as Phishing.
- Make sure that the address in your browser is genuine and does belong to the website you need to access.
- Never click on a link within an email requesting that you enter your username, password, etc. The link can also be malicious.
- Never give out sensitive personal or account information to someone that asks via email unless you have verified the message's authenticity.

2. Change your password on regular basis as per the password policy.

It is recommended to change passwords on a regular basis

3. Do not share your password with anyone.

> Don't share your password. As a rule, never share it with anyone.

4. Always remember to sign out properly after using your mail account.

Always log out of your email when finished

5. Do not save or remember your password anywhere.

6. Use Anti-Virus software & update it on regular basis.

- It is also highly recommended to install and maintain an anti-virus software on your computer to prevent infection from USB drives and Make sure it is updated regularly. Scan all attachments with a virus program before downloading/executing any, even if they come from someone you know.
- Computers that are infected with spyware/key loggers record every word that users are typing, hence a daily scan is recommended.

7. Update the operating system and application patches

Users need to ensure that their desktop/laptop has the latest operating system and application patches. If the patch levels are not updated, updated anti-virus software will not be able to prevent an infection. Both anti-virus and operating system patches need to work together.

8. Never open / respond any mail / attachment from unknown sender.

9. Never subscribe your email ID on unsafe locations (over internet).

10. Scan systems regularly.

Do scan devices such as Pen Drives, Media such as CDs for viruses in a system with latest Anti-virus updates before using.

Do protect access to PC using password and do not disclose passwords to anyone. In case of necessity, the password may be disclosed to authorized person only. However, pass word should be changed immediately afterwards.

Website is the face of the company which decides whether we are capable and popular enough in this competitive world or not? As we all know, face is the index of the body structure so it has to be maintained properly so that we can be presentable in front of everyone and the same is with the website which has to be designed properly with appropriate designs and tags.

Website can be Static and Dynamic:-

A Static website is the most basic type of website and contains web pages with fixed content. Each page is coded in HTML and displays the same information to every user.

A Dynamic website is a website that displays different types of content every time a user views it.

What is CSS?

CSS is cascading style sheets it defines style look and formatting of a webpage. What is Bootstrap?

Bootstrap is a free front-end framework for faster and easier web development. It includes various templates, forms buttons tables, optional JavaScript plugins etc.

Main points which have to be remembered while designing of Web page and Website:

- 1) Entire website has to be divided in various webpages
- Each webpage should have basic html tags like <html>, <head>, <body>, <section>, <div>, etc.
- 3) Whenever new webpage of a website is being designed CSS pages whose styles and formats have to be used in particular webpage that have to be called on the top of the webpage under basic <head> tag of the html
- 4) It's a good practice to write simultaneously open tag and close tag at a time inside the tags write the description or mention the various <section>(various sections) and <div>(various divisions) which inturn makes the structure of the particular webpage.
- Mention contact details on index page of the website and use different icons or images with a hyperlink to have detailed contact details on another webpage
- 6) Use more and more images, icons.
- 7) Use more and more colours.
- Instead of vast data and making more web pages describe latest news and events with images or posters
- 9) Keep the content up to the mark and concise (without having many links on the same web page use a main webpage inside that define another webpage) by using <a> (anchor tags) and by href (hyperlinks)
- 10) Define margins, fonts, font-size, colours, background images, etc which will be same for entire website in CSS so that directly particular CSS page can be called in various webpages
- Use features of drop down for having various webpages under main webpage by defining drop down class in CSS and by (unordered list tag) and (list tags)Need to have basic knowledge of html and CSS
- 12) Need to have basic knowledge of script language
- Design a simple but attractive footer to the entire webpages and most probably same footer for entire webpages. Footer can be designed by using <footer>(footer tag)
- 14) Design a footer which attracts viewers to see by using images, various colours .Footer of the page is mainly used for defining about the content and update status of the website with date.
- 15) While designing official website collect data from various departments which is required to be presented on the website.
- 16) Mainly goal of the company i.e. Services what is done by the company should be highlighted with various effects, images and colours
- 17) And last but not least have self-confidence, have patience, refer various sites, ask for suggestions and try to implement the things which make look of the website good.


